I sincerely hope that this letter finds you and your family safe and well. We are writing to share some information with you with regard to plans for the Transition Year class as we approach the end of the school year as follows:

Assessment:

The unusual period of quarantine has resulted in changes in the criteria and system for assessment from previous years where the assessment results were reported to parents twice in the school year and were calculated separately. Following consultation with management, teachers, the Student Council and Transition Year students we have decided that the final results will reflect the entire year's work. The results will be weighted in a 60%:40% ratio, and, where possible, assessments carried out prior to the school closure will be awarded the greater proportion of marks.

The assessment will be divided into two main sections as follows

- ♣ Continuous Assessment in subjects and modules weighted in the 60%:40% ratio
- ♣ A Portfolio Presentation again weighted in the 60%:40% ratio.
