Classes finish for all students on Friday 28th May

To facilitate the Leaving Cert Accredited Grades Process this year, the Department of Education announced in recent months that classes for all students will finish on Friday 28th May. Classes will be held from 9am to 12 noon on that day.

Academic Progress

School Management and Teachers are monitoring your daughter's progress. The Class Test system that we introduced for all year groups this year has worked very well. It was introduced to ensure that the girls were assessed on material being covered this term and to reduce any concerns/anxieties that some students may have at this time.

Financial Support toward the cost of the Book Rental Scheme

The Department of Education and Skills give all schools funding to support Needy Students

A needy student is defined as a student from a family where there is:

- Genuine hardship because of unemployment or short time working
- Prolonged illness of a parent
- Large family size with inadequate means
- Single parenthood
- Other family circumstances (e.g. alcoholism) indicating a similar degree of financial hardship

The Department of Education and Science guidelines divide such families into the following three categories:

- Families which are dependent mainly on social welfare payments
- Families on low incomes from employment (Such families should be in receipt of the Family Income Supplement (FIS) or beneficiaries under the Back-to-School Clothing and Footwear scheme)
- Families which are experiencing financial hardship because of particular circumstances in the
